Three categories of incentives are offered:

Prescriptive

Prescriptive Measure	Maximum Incentive
All off-switch	\$50
ENERGY STAR® Air Conditioner	\$30
Lighting Control Products	\$3
ENERGY STAR® Qualified indoor light fixtures	\$3-\$10
ENERGY STAR® Qualified Niche Lighting	\$5

Performance-based

The performance-based incentives for new homes are as follows:

A new home that achieves an EnerGuide 83 or 84 performance rating or is ENERGY STAR® qualified is eligible for up to \$500.

A new home that achieves an EnerGuide 85 or better performance rating is eligible for up to \$1,000.

Custom


This funding stream is exclusively for innovative, cost-effective, energy-efficiency building projects that do not qualify under either the Prescriptive or Performance-Based funding streams. Incentives are the greater of \$800/kW for First Year Demand Savings, or \$0.10/kWh for First Year Energy Savings.

Application Process:

- 1) Submit Preliminary Application Project Worksheet and receive pre-approval from your local distribution company prior to framing or structural work aside from pouring of the foundation.
- 2) Complete construction.
- 3) Fill out the Final Application Project Worksheet.
- 4) Submit the Final Application Project Worksheet along with the following:
 - a. Occupancy Permits for every home
 - b. Copies of EnerGuide Energy Efficiency Evaluation Report or ENERGY STAR® Qualified New Home Certificate for each home applying for performance based incentives.



Builders must apply before construction begins so don't delay!
