Township of Alfred-Plantagenet Wendover WTP Intake and Low Lift Pumping System Schedule B Class Environmental Assessment

The Township of Alfred-Plantagenet has initiated a Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) to determine the most suitable expansion and/or upgrades to the Wendover Water Treatment Plant (WTP)'s intake and low-lift pumping system to effectively provide drinking water to the existing service population and potential future developments.

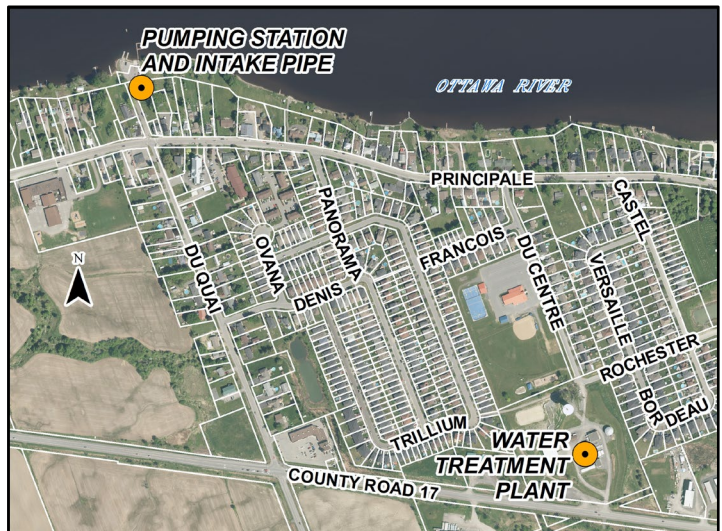
How Will This Affect Me?

The study will assess current & future requirements of the Wendover WTP's **intake and low-lift pumping system** and will make recommendations for upgrading and/or expanding the system to meet the needs of the Wendover community. Public & agency consultation is a key element of the Class EA process. Based on your input, alternative strategies will be evaluated to identify optimal community, environmental and economic opportunities.

How Do I Get More Information?

One Public Information Centre (PIC) will be conducted in the summer of 2026 prior to finalizing the preferred solution. In the meantime, the study team is reviewing background data and determining alternative solutions.
